Minimum Academic Requirements (if English is not your first language, then candidates must also meet the University's English language requirements): MA by Research candidates will be expected to hold or be predicted a BA 2.1 or above or equivalent. PhD candidates will be expected to hold or be studying towards an MA in a relevant discipline. The School's English language requirement is IELTS 6.5 with not less than 6.0 in any skill.

Any Additional Requirements:

Applicants should apply for a place to study at the University of Leeds and then apply for the scholarship.

We welcome scholarship applications from all suitably-qualified candidates, but UK black and minority ethnic (BME) researchers are currently under-represented in our Postgraduate Research community, and we would therefore particularly encourage applications from UK BME candidates. All scholarships will be awarded on the basis of merit.
